* BullCharts – Popular / Useful Key Features

(a starting list, with more items to be added)

Favourite chart indicators and tools:

1. MACD and SMACD (Des)
2. Donchian Channel (DavidW)
3. Build an indicator ribbon to simplify one or more indicators.
4. Higher Highs (HHV)
5. Candlestick patterns (and indicator)
6. ROC (Rate of Change) (Phil)
7. Count Back Lines (CBL) (Phil)
8. Stop Loss tools and indicators:-
 - (a) Jim Berg Volatility Profit Taker
 - (b) Welles Wilder Volatility Stop
 - (c) Chandelier Exit stop
 - (d) Chande Volatility Trailing Stop
 - (e) Wilson ATR Trailing Stop
9. Fundamental Report indicator
10. Comparative Percent Performance
11. OBV plus its Moving Average

Key features:

1. Scan with "Match all criteria" turned off, so as to produce a "Score" (RBB)
2. IntelliCharts – "Save different ... for each time period"
3. Turn IntelliCharts off, and then "Save..." as a chart.
4. Adding text to price chart (Des)
5. Heikin Ashi candles (Alek, Paul)
6. "Delete all (elements)": <Ctrl>+
7. "Dividend Vertical Lines" (RBB)
8. Log scale
9. "Insert Security" to put extra security price charts onto the first chart.
10. Time axis: Zoom, Compress, etc.
11. Differentiate between Templates and Workspaces, and "Save..."
12. Multiple price charts – for same security, or for different securities.
13. Backup key user data.
14. Alerts.
15. Layer Manager
16. Extra databases
