






















Recording notes using software 1. Some charting software packages will automatically "remember" various lines, notes and annotations that you add to your price chart for each stock. 2. In BullCharts this feature is IntelliCharts. 3. In some tools there can be limitations: (a) Only one chart open for each stock, which will limit the analysis; (b) The annotations apply across all time periods (ie. daily, weekly, monthly, etc.).
