· Scans - Specify selection criteria, and



Some home truths about "trading"	
<ul> <li>Day-trading can be a lonely experience, sitting in front of a screen all day (but it does not have to be this way)</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Every one has some losses – you need to accept this, and minimise them</li> </ul>	
Try to maximise the profits	
<ul> <li>If you follow the "rules", you might come out ahead</li> </ul>	
If not, then you could have significant losses.

proper money mgt     proper position sizing     discipline     discipline     confident     commitment     commitment     responsibility     psychology	
<ul> <li>intuition</li> <li>relevant experience</li> <li>goal setting</li> <li>willingness to learn</li> <li>action oriented</li> </ul>	
Note: "Day trading" — Is a specialised activity, and rather different to inter-day trading!!!
